

REGULAR ALGEBRA FINAL STUDY GUIDE

- The final is 35 multiple-choice questions and 20 free response questions.
- Each section of the final exam will be worth 100 points.
- The final exam is worth 15% of your semester grade.
- The exam covers all of chapters 8 and 9 as well as Sections: 7-1, 7-2, 7-5, 7-6, 7-10, 10-1, 10-2, 10-3 and pp. 600-620 of your textbook.

As you study for your final, you will need to keep track of what you do in a “Final Exam Study Log.” Please see the attached paper for an example of the format. **The study log will be worth 100 points in your homework section.** The goal of the log is that you are keeping track of what material you have covered and are determining what topics you most need to study. Since there will be no official homework assigned you must keep an accurate reflection of what you are doing at home. **It is expected that you will be studying at least 30 minutes each evening before your final.** We will also be spending each class period reviewing material for the final. Each time you study, you need to make an entry in your log. Also, after each day in class, you are expected to make an entry in your log. All logs are due the day of the final exam.

Mrs. Baird’s Recommendation for studying

- 1st Take the end of chapter tests AND the Chapter Reviews. (the Chapter Reviews have multiple choice practice, both are located at the end of each chapter)
- 2nd Score your self and write down the sections of the problems you got wrong.
- 3rd Go to those sections (either in the book or on your final review packet) and do some of the problems from that section.
- 4th 2-3 days before your final exam, take the “practice final.” Score yourself.
- 5th Work through the practice final, correcting any mistakes.
